"UNTIL THIS WORD..."

Paul was preaching in Jerusalem. The Jews were busy stirring up the people against him. After making some false charges against Paul, they began to beat him seeking to kill him. (Acts 21:26-32.) The commander and soldiers came to see what the commotion was about. When no firm answers were forthcoming Paul was placed in chains and taken back to the barracks. (Acts 21:33-37.)

Paul asked the commander if he could address the crowd. Given permission, the discourse begins in Acts 22. Paul told them of his past life and his conversion to Christ, then how he had been warned about coming to Jerusalem. Finally, he told how the Lord sent him to preach to the Gentiles. "And they listened to him until this word ... "{Acts 22:22}

What happened? Did Paul lie to them? Of course not. They "heard" something they could not agree with. So they cut off his sermon! Sadly, what happened to Paul still happens today. People will discuss religion matters with you, listen very carefully, until you say "the word". What is this "word"? It varies depending on the discussion. Let me give you two examples.

There Is Only ONE Savior. When we begin to discuss that salvation is in Christ alone, some say they have heard enough! What saith the scriptures?

"Therefore 1 said to you that you will die in your sins; for if you do not believe that 1 am He, you will die in your sins. "{John 8:24}

"Jesus said to him, I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. $\{John 14:6\}$

Who died for your sins? Who gave you redemption? Who reconciled you back to God? "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." {Romans 5:8}

"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace" {Ephesians 1:7}

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.
