The Lord's Supper was instituted on the night of His betrayal, Matthew 26:26-29. Let us examine the mighty message that is sent by the memorial of His death.

Kingdom is established. "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom." (Matthew 26:29) Paul's instructions to the church at Corinth tells us they were observing that supper-thus the kingdom is here. 1 Corinthians 11:23-33.

**Jesus did die**. "But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us." {Romans 5:8}Christ's death on that cruel cross of Calvary gave us an opportunity of everlasting life. No forgiveness is possible without the shedding of blood, Hebrews 9:22.

**Need for self examination**. " But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body." {I Corinthians 11:27,29} When one partakes of those sacred emblems we must be sure our minds go back to the cross.

The Lord's Supper is a very important part of what we do each Lord's day. It reminds us of the high price paid for our salvation. It also shows us the love God has for the world and His hatred for sin. Such a great price was paid on that tree so long ago.
