## SEVEN THINGS THE LORD HATES

"These six things the LORD hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, A lying tongue, Hands that shed innocent blood, A heart that devises wicked plans, Feet that are swift in running to evil, A false witness who speaks lies, And one who sows discord among brethren." (Proverbs 6:16-19) The wise man Solomon list seven things that the Lord's hates.

"**A Proud Look**." Mean haughty eyes. A lofty expression can reveal the wrong kind of pride in a person. God does not want His people to look down upon others. God's people are to be humble and meek. Matthew 5:5; James 4:6-8

**"A Lying Tongue**." "I hate and abhor lying, but I love Your law. " {Psalm 119: 160} Lying is something we are to put off when we become Christians, Colossians 3:9. Many times lying seems the best way out of a difficult situation. We are told that all liars will have a part in the lake of fire. Revelation 21:8

"Hands That Shed Innocent Blood." This is of course murder. God hates the willful taking of human life. Cain was cursed for murdering Abel. Genesis 4: 7-9 God gave Noah a law concerning the murderer, Genesis 9:6. Life is a precious thing and should be valued by all human beings. Murderers will also be lost! Where does this place the folks who support and perform abortions in our country? Can one truly believe that these folks don't have blood on their hands—innocent blood!

"A Heart That Deviseth Wicked Imaginations." A heart that is busy scheming, plotting, wicked things. Our minds must be kept pure. Proverbs 20:7; 1 Timothy 5:22.
