Whenever the subject of religion comes up in conversation, many questions will be asked concerning the book of Revelation.

"And they cried with a loud voice, saying, "How long, o Lord, holy and true, until You judge and avenge our blood on those who dwell on the earth? Then a white robe was given to each of them; and it was said to them that they should rest a little while longer, until both the number of their fellow servants and their brethren, who would be killed as they were, was completed. " {Revelation 6: 10,11} When the time was fulfilled, God would bring judgment upon Rome. History tells us the truth of His promise!

"And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it." {Revelation 5:3,4}
