"God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear, Even though the earth be removed, And though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;" {Psalms 46:1,2}

What is a "**refuge**"? "Protection or shelter, as from danger or hardship; A source of help, relief, or comfort in times of trouble." (American Heritage Dictionary) God is our source of comfort in times of trouble. How so?

"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." {Philippians 4:13}

"Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing." {2 Timothy 4:8}
