"Lead me in Your truth and teach me, For You are the God of my salvation; On You I wait all the day." {Psalms 25:5}

"I waited patiently for the LORD; And He inclined to me, and heard my cry." {Psalms 20:1}

"I wait for the LORD, my soul waits, and in His word I do hope." {Psalm 130:5}
