THREE PRESENT BLESSINGS

Let's discuss what the Scriptures say about some of our **present blessings**:

Forgiveness of Sins. "Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins; and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses." {Acts 13:38,39}
